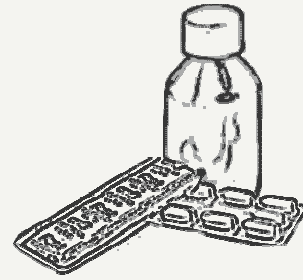


Paracetamol

The most common medicine involved in child poisoning in New Zealand.

Never leave on the bench between uses -
Put all medicines away immediately



Bleaches/Cleaners

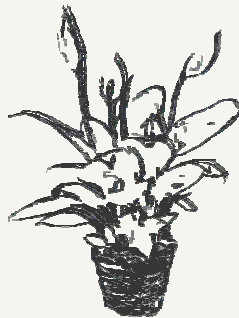


Bleach and cleaners are so readily available
- every house has them

Always store cleaners out of sight & reach
of children in a locked cupboard

Indoor Plants

Children can enjoy

Know your plants and

- even vase water

toxic

Dishwashing Liquid



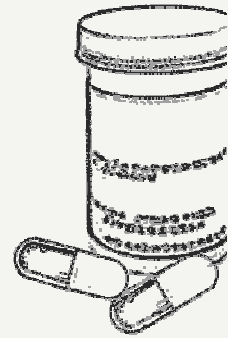
The most common chemical involved in child poisoning in New Zealand

Always store chemicals in original containers -
Never use drink bottles!

Antibiotics

Antibiotics are common poisons when children are already sick

Always dispose of unused medicines by taking them to the pharmacy



Dishwasher Powder

Powder can remain in the dishwasher after the cycle



Use a flow restrictor & child-safety cap -
Ensure cap is always put back correctly
