



## Fertilisers

Always follow the instructions and use protective clothing when suggested by the manufacturer



## Snail Bait




Snail Bait can sometimes get caught up in lettuce or cabbage - wash your veges carefully

Dispose of old garden chemicals safely - Even "empty" packs must be out of reach

## Pool Chemicals

Pool Chemicals can produce chlorine gas if mixed with other chemicals




Always handle carefully and read the instructions - Adults can be poisoned too

## Insects

Some people can be allergic to stings or bites and need to carry life-saving medicine

Always remove stingers carefully and wash the wound with water and disinfectant. Ice may help numb the pain.



## Garden Plants




10% of child poisonings in New Zealand involve plants

Remove berries that fall on paths or lawns accessible to children

## Spiders

Spiders are found in homes and gardens. Even "non-toxic" spiders can bite if cornered



Any spider bite should be washed and disinfected straight away. If possible, keep the spider for identification
