

## Ant Baits



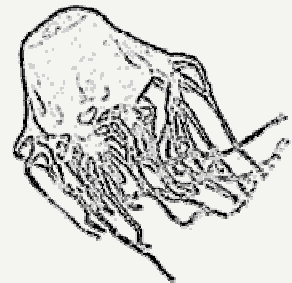
Ants can be a problem in holiday homes so be aware the last visitor may have left bait out

## Jellyfish

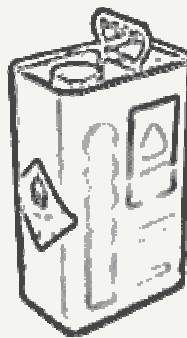
The most common New Zealand Jellyfish is the Blue Bottle

Fuels are widely used everywhere around the house, shed & garage

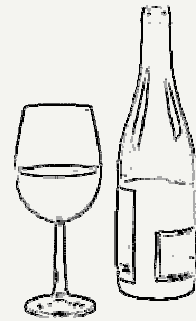


Always choose products with a child-resistant lid, but remember these are not child proof

## Insect Spray



Heavy, repeated applications of repellent can be absorbed through the skin

Never let children apply insect repellent unsupervised.  
Always follow instructions on the bottle

## Sunscreen

During summer, sunscreen is often left within reach of young children



Always supervise young children in applying sunscreen, & put it away straight after use
